We have a staffed nursery from 8:00 a.m. until the end of the 10:30 service. There's a coloring table and activity bags at the back of church, for parents and children. Our basement and nursery are equipped with speakers to hear the service if you need to step away at any time. Please consider our hearing impaired members who sometimes struggle with ancillary noise. Our pews have children's Bibles and Prayer Books to help guide them through the service. If you prefer a more meditative or shorter worship service, please consider joining us at 8:00 a.m. Greeters, ushers and clergy can answer questions. Join us for refreshments after the service. We want to meet you & hope your worship is a blessing.
